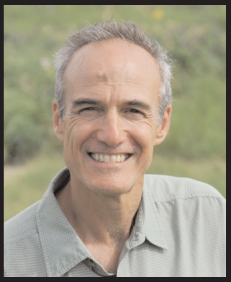


# Earth, Wind, Fire & Climate Change
