During this walking tour of the new waterfront development you'll learn how Thunder Bay has successfully:

- ★ Built lasting partnerships, strong community support, and a bright vision for the future.
- ★ Connected public art, nature, and economic growth to support a thriving and dynamic urban, mixed-use area.

You'll also learn how HOCP partners in in Minnesota and Ontario are working together to:

- ★ Support regional tourism through development of a *Lake Superior Heritage Coast* travel corridor from the Pigeon River to Sault Ste. Marie.
- ★ Raise public awareness of how the **Sister Cities of Thunder Bay, ON and Duluth, MN** are connected by the North Shore Scenic Drive ("Two Nations, One Route").

DIRECTIONS TO THE MARINA PARK:

- 1. Driving in ON-61 N as you enter Thunder Bay you will see the "paper mill" to your right as you travel over the Kam River Bridge.
- 2. Continue on ON-61-N pass by the Thunder Bay Airport on your left.
- 3. Pass through the lights at the Airport.
- 4. Continue through the second set of lights at Arthur St. (Travel Lodge Airlane is on your right and the Valhalla Inn will be on your left)
- 5. Turn right at Harbour Expressway. The next major intersection about 4.2 km from airport. Head east toward Lake Superior.
- 6. Travel 3.4 km down Harbour Expressway, passing through 3 (three) sets of lights at Golf Links Road, Balmoral and Memorial Ave.
- 7. Turn left off Harbour Expressway onto Fort William Rd at the fourth set of lights. Sears and InterCity Shopping Centre will be on your right.
- 8. Head North on Fort William Road which now becomes Water Street (still the same road).
- 9. Travel about 5 KM North along the waterfront parallel to the rail line passing through three sets of lights at Central Ave, John St. and Bay St.
- 10. About 1 KM past Bay St. prepare to turn right into Prince Arthur's Landing (Marina Park)
- 11. Turn right at Pearl St. into "Prince Arthur's Landing' (Marina Park) (the Fire Hall will be on your left)
 - (Note: If you miss the Pearl St. entrance continue on Water St. and at the second set of lights turn right and use the Marina Park Overpass to enter the Park. (Prince Arthur's Landing)
- 12. Head east down Pearl St. entrance road and then turn left at stop sign.
- 13. Head north down the service road to connect over to the historic CN Station
- 14. Turn right at the CN Station
- 15. Baggage Building is 100 feet on your left. (Parking is to your right behind the Water Garden Pavilion).
